

## Outcomes from Graduate Preparation Course

Below are comments from students who completed Advanced Math II, an intensive graduate preparation course I designed with student placement in mind at King's College London. The course featured two hours of lecture, one hour of tutorial for small groups and two hours of large group tutorial a week. During the course, students had not only weekly assignments, but a large group project requiring them to both master the course material and also practice independence and self reliance by discovering related methods on their own. The quantity of work was such that they would have to learn and explain various parts to each other, reinforcing understanding and clarifying their ideas. The knowledge, soft skills and confidence this engenders will help them hit the ground running in top graduate programs or working in technical environments.
